

RESOLUTION NO. 1471

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A COMMUNITY HEALTH AND WELLNESS ADVISORY COMMITTEE FOR THE CITY OF ST. PETERS

WHEREAS, citizen wellness and rising health care cost issues are critical problems of the twenty-first century, and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to encourage and involve citizens to promote active living, healthy eating, and overall wellness in their communities; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to provide a framework by which we can work with the community to develop and implement outreach, education and technical assistance activities towards the goal of healthier citizens and lower health care costs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF ST. PETERS, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the City of St. Peters Board of Aldermen hereby establishes the City of St. Peters Community Health & Wellness Advisory Committee to advise the City of St. Peters elected officials and staff on health and wellness issues, and assist in efforts to inform and educate the St. Peters community and to identify practices and programs that promote active living.


SECTION 2. That the Advisory Board be composed of eight (8) persons, appointed by the Mayor with the consent of the Board of Aldermen, who have expertise and/or an interest in wellness and health related issues. Three (3) of those appointed are not required to reside within the corporate city limits of St. Peters if those persons possess special expertise deemed essential or desirable on the Advisory Committee.

In addition, the Mayor, with the consent of the Board of Aldermen, shall appoint two (2) members of the Board of Aldermen to serve as *ex officio* members of the Advisory Board who shall be entitled to be present and participate in all meetings of the Advisory Board but shall have no right to vote in the deliberations of the Advisory Board. Members of the Board of Aldermen selected to serve as liaisons with the Advisory Board shall serve thereon for a term of two (2) years, or until their respective successors are duly appointed, or until such time as such person no longer holds the office of Alderman in the City, whichever shall occur first.”

SECTION 3. Initially, the Advisory Committee shall meet no less than once a month, **on the fourth Monday of each month.**

SECTION 4. That this Advisory Committee shall report their activities and make recommendations regarding health and wellness issues and/or programs to the Board of Aldermen.
