Lakeside 370

The new floating dock has been installed in the harbor; as well as the courtesy dock by the boat launch.

Staff is currently working on finishing grade work at the comfort station and widening the canal near pump station 2 to allow a larger volume of water to the pump.

The trails around the lake and adjacent to Spencer Road have been completed. With the completion of these trails, the City's trail system now totals 20 miles.

The lake will be closed December, January and February.
