1. This agreement is between the City of St. Peters and the applicant named above for the 2016 season, March 1 – October 31. Please Note: water spigot will not be turned on until April 1.
2. Garden plots will be tilled at the beginning of the season (prior to March 1, weather permitting).
3. Each plot is approximately 10' by 8'. There are also two raised garden beds at each Garden. The raised plots are approximately 9'6" x 7'6". The fee for a season will be \$20.00 per plot. Limit of two plots per household; with only one raised plot allowed per household. The limit per household will be waived for any plots not reserved by March 1.
4. Plots will be assigned on a first come, first served basis.
5. No plot can be gardened until payment of fees and a signed application is received and approved.
6. The garden will be accessible during daylight hours only. Sunrise to sunset.
7. Any necessary garden tools, seeds, fertilizers, hoses, etc. must be provided by the gardener.
8. Each gardener agrees to use the plot at his own risk and agrees to hold the City of St. Peters harmless from any injury, damage and/or theft.
9. Gardeners must be at least 18 years of age or be accompanied by an adult who is 18 years of age or older.
10. Gardeners must remove all vegetation from garden plots at the end of the season (October 31).
11. If a plot has noxious weeds or has not been maintained for two weeks or more, the City may remove all vegetation from the site and it may be assigned to another gardener. No refunds will be given for sites not maintained.
12. Each gardener must agree to the following Rules and Regulations:
 - a. Conserve water and turn off all faucets after watering. Never leave water running unattended.
 - b. Grow only legal plants.
 - c. Maintain a neat plot throughout the growing season, harvest produce and flowers when mature, remove plants when they have ceased to bear, and keep it free from weeds.
 - d. Comply fully with all federal and state laws and regulations regarding the use of pesticides and chemicals and ensure that any application of such products remains strictly limited to garden plot.
 - e. Be considerate of neighbors.
 - f. Deposit all litter into trash barrels and vegetative matter into designated compost piles or barrels.
 - g. Keep pets out of the garden area.
 - h. Supervise any children brought into the garden area.
 - i. Never drive or park on the grass.
 - j. Never apply anything to or pick anything from another person's plot without their permission.
 - k. Inform the Garden Coordinator if finished gardening before the end of the season.
