

**Minutes of March 16, 2023**  
**St Peters Senior Advisory Committee**

**Meeting called to Order-** The meeting was called to order at by Debbie Coval at 12:32 pm at The St. Peters Mayor Tom Brown Senior Center.

**Approval of Minutes-** A motion to approve the January 2023 minutes could not be made due to the minutes not be distributed prior to the meeting. It was agreed the minutes would be distributed and approved at the next meeting.

**Public Comments-** Mayor Pagano spoke about the upcoming Prop S & Prop M ballot measures that will be up for vote on April 4, 2023. He provided flyers with information about the planned use of tax revenue and why the measures has been placed on the ballot.

New members, Catherine Rahlmann and Robin Frye were welcomed to the committee and introductions were made.

**Items of Discussion-** The Senior Networking event has been approved and scheduled for April 25, 2023 from 5-7 pm at the St. Peters Cultural Arts Center. Emily advised she will work with the City's Communications Department on advertising and will provide information to committee members to disperse as well.

Emily asked for members of the Committee to attend the upcoming City of St. Charles Senior Activities Fair on March 30<sup>th</sup> at the Foundry Art Center to represent St. Peters. At the request of the committee, a table was reserved and flyers about St. Peters events and activities have been collected to give out. No one from St. Peters was able to attend the planning meeting on March


14<sup>th</sup>. Debra Coval and Alderman Violet agreed to represent St. Peters at the event. Roger Young indicated he would be attending the event if backup was needed.

It was asked when the City of O'Fallon's Senior Fair would be held and the date, May 3<sup>rd</sup>, was given. Emily advised she will provide more details and the planned location when they are known.
