PRESENTATIONS

Dan Emrick presented the 'End of the Year Report' for the Parks & Recreation Department. The City of St Peters made significant progress in many areas of the Parks, Recreation and Cultural Arts facilities and programs. COVID-19 did effect the overall usage of parks, Rec- Plex, 370 Lakeside Park, Golf Course, and Cultural Arts Centre. All facilities were closed at some point due to COVID-19. Specifics of these were well documented in the presentation.

Dan also discussed the Recreation Master Plan that was completed by PRO's Consulting, Inc. and adopted by the Board of Aldermen in December, 2020. The Master Plan has a 5-Year Plan that include initiatives for utilization, financing, maintenance, membership and culture. The Recreation Master Plan is available to view on the City's web page.

NEW BUSINESS

Dan Emrick reports that Rec Plex South DTC has been leased to the St Peters Spirits Hockey Club.

The City has renewed the Cooperative Agreement with the City of St. Charles. The Agreement offers resident rates to St. Peters residents for use of the outdoor pools in St. Charles and resident rates to St. Charles residents for Rec-Plex Memberships.

Laurel Park's address has changed to 3000 McClay Valley. The new address is to direct visitors to the entrance of the park that has the most parking available.

FOCUS COMMITTEE REPORTS

Arts Focus Committee:

The Arts Centre will be reaching out to local school districts to work on a plan of increasing teen and young adult involvement in the arts.

The Mayor would like a member of the Parks, Recreation and Arts Advisory Board in attendance at the Art Receptions. Receptions occur every 6-8 weeks and include the announcement of winners from the Art Show Competition & Exhibition that is currently on display.

Golf Focus Committee:

The last Focus Committee meeting was cancelled but another one is scheduled in February.

Historical Committee:

It was suggested that contact should be made with the St Charles County Historical Society to request information on St Peters historical data and growth. The group also wants to contact Dan Brown, former Superintendent of the Francis Howell School District. He has a collection of St Charles County historical data, including St Peters. Alderman Barclay suggested the committee contact the State of Missouri Historical Society and/or travel to Jefferson City. The purpose would be to review and obtain St Peters historical data and pictures.

Sustainability Focus Committee:

One objective is to highlight eco-friendly recycling tips the City's website once a month. Also, continue to highlight how to recycle hazardous materials by using the website. This includes the partnership with the St Charles County recycling operation.

MISCELLANEOUS

Lucian Nevatt's Army Reserve Unit has been mobilized so Lucian will not be reappointed when his term expires at the end of January. Lucian will serve in a Training Unit in Texas.

Don Mosley, Parks Board Member, congratulated St Peters City staff and the Board of Aldermen for doing an excellent job for residents during the very difficult COVID-19 pandemic.
