



**PARKS, RECREATION, AND ARTS ADVISORY BOARD MEETING

September 15, 2020**

CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Amanda Darnell called the meeting to order at 6:00 pm at the Cultural Arts Centre.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

July 15, 2020, minutes were approved as presented.

PRESENTATION

Amy Haddock, Director of Storm Water for the City of St. Peters, gave a presentation on Storm Water Management. Highlights of the presentation included background of storm water management and implementation of Prop P Storm Water Projects. In 2011, a sales tax was passed, and the City has been able to utilize the funding for design and construction of 78 project areas. A list of accomplishments and completed projects were included in the presentation. The next three projects to be completed will address selected bank stabilization areas along the Dardenne Creek.

MANAGER'S REPORT

Brian Bacyinski gave the following report regarding the Recreation Department: the Rec-Plex continues to re-open in phases. Improvements to the Natatorium have been completed enough that a high school swim meet can be held on September 8. The pool is scheduled to be open for lap swimming on September 14. There were some delays with the Natatorium

improvements including a problem with the no slip coating on the floor by the bleachers, the shipment of supplies for the moveable floor in the 50M pool was incomplete and incorrect and the stain used in the plaster of the Leisure Pool. The fitness areas are now open to members only. Public ice skating sessions require a reservation with a reduced capacity to allow for social distancing. Ice rinks at Rec-Plex South are up and running with hockey games and practices. There has been a strong effort from staff to sanitize all areas of the Rec-Plex in order to reduce the spread of germs. State Wars In-line Hockey Tournament has been approved for 2021. The Strategic Management Plan completed for the Rec-Plex recommended a re-focus on members, which is the direction staff is working on.

Jill Tutt gave the following report regarding the Cultural Arts Centre: Arts Centre events scheduled for September and October, including bus tours, City Centre Dances, and St. Charles County Symphony Orchestra's Halloween Concert have all been cancelled due to the COVID-19 Pandemic. Renovations of the Arts Centre restrooms have been delayed and are now scheduled to re-open the first week of October. The Arts Centre is now on Facebook and Twitter and there were 200 likes for the first month. Act II Community Theatre Group has decided to push back their schedule and only have three performances in 2021. St. Peters Performing Arts Studio (Piano & Voice Lessons) have terminated their rental usage of the Cultural Arts Centre. Jill will be looking for a new tenant for the music rooms (located on the upper level outside of the Performing Arts Theatre). Art displays will finally be returning to the Arts Centre on October 22 with the "\$100 or Less" Art Show. The first Art Show for next year is entitled Let's Celebrate, which will begin in January. The City will participate in the Missouri Bicentennial Celebration by having a special art show next June. The Mayor Tom Brown Senior Center will be getting a gallery hanging system, just like the Arts Centre has, to be able to display artwork.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

The order for tree seedlings for the Arbor Day Tree Giveaway has been placed. We should know by the end of the year if the trees we requested are available.

NEW BUSINESS

FOCUS COMMITTEE REPORTS

The Sustainability Focus Committee met prior to the PRAB Meeting and has started working on a mission statement.

MISCELLANEOUS

COMMENTS FROM ELECTED OFFICIALS

Alderman Barclay inquired if the City is considering holding another Olympic event since the Summer Olympics will be held in Los Angeles in 2028. Alderman Barclay also inquired about the Shred It event on November 8th.

Alderman Townsend gave information about an Eagle Scout Flag Retirement Ceremony that will be held at 370 Lakeside Park on September 19, 2020.

Alderman Reimer encouraged members to sign up for the Arts Centre Facebook Page to find out what new things are happening.

Alderman Trupiano complimented staff on the detailed reports that were provided.

Alderman Barclay announced that the Historical Focus Committee will be meeting on September 30 and watch for the meeting notice.


