

FINAL PUBLIC NOTICE

The City of St. Peters, Missouri, has applied for Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) Public Assistance (PA) funding through Missouri State Emergency Management Agency (SEMA) as a Subrecipient.

Under the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA), federal actions must be reviewed and evaluated for feasible alternatives and for social, economic, historic, environmental, legal, and safety considerations. Under Executive Order (EO) 11988 Floodplain Management and EO 11990 Wetlands Protection, FEMA is required to consider alternatives, and to provide a public notice of any proposed actions in or affecting floodplains or wetlands. The public is invited to participate in the review. The public may identify alternatives for restoring the facility and may participate in analyzing the impact of the alternatives on the facility and the floodplain.

Funding for the proposed project will be conditional upon compliance with all applicable federal, tribal, state, and local laws, regulations, floodplain standards, permit requirements, and conditions.

Special Flood Hazard Area Zone:

The five parks are located in a Zone AE Special Flood Hazard Area, known as the 100-year floodplain per the City of St. Peters Flood Insurance Rate Map (FIRM) identified above, dated 01/20/2016. There is potential for the facilities to be impacted by future flooding events due to its location within the special flood hazard area. Portions of the proposed work will take place adjacent to a mapped wetlands however it is not likely to have an adverse impact. The work will conform to all applicable State of Missouri and local floodplain regulations.

Proposed Work and Purpose:

City of St. Peters proposes to reset and replace fencing at several parks, replace artificial turf mats, pads and associated materials, replace sand and pea gravel at the putting green, reset a shed building on its pad, replace a pond pump, and update the irrigation system and wiring at the golf club.

Project Alternatives:

Alternative #1 (No action): The 'no action' alternative would leave the parks and golf course surfaces damaged and the city unable to properly water greens and fairways.

Alternative #2 (Relocation): This alternative is not practicable as there is no practicable available land within St. Peters for relocation.

Alternative #3 (Repairs, no mitigation): This option is being pursued, to restore fencing, replace turf and green, replace pond pump, reset the shed building, as well as fixing the irrigation system and wiring. This will make the facilities more resilient to flooding.
