## EQUIPMENT RENTAL RULES

1. A valid driver's license is required to rent equipment.
2. Checks are not accepted. Payment can be made with cash, VISA, MasterCard or Discover.
3. You are responsible for all rented equipment. Do not abuse or leave unattended.
4. If equipment is lost, stolen or damaged, you are responsible for the cost of the equipment.
5. You are responsible for any mechanical breakdowns that occur during your rental, for example flat tires.
6. Equipment use is at your own risk, and a liability waiver must be signed.
7. Must be 18 or older to reserve equipment.
8. Inspect the equipment and make sure everything is in good working order before leaving.
9. Bicycles must obey all traffic regulations, and watercraft must obey all open water regulations.
10. Customers should be aware of their surroundings, and be prepared to seek shelter during threatening weather conditions.
11. 370 Lakeside Park is habitat to a variety of wildlife. Please be respectful of your surroundings and avoid direct contact with animals, birds and snakes.
