



INFORMATION FOR ALL PAVILION RESERVATIONS

In order to follow current recommendations for preventing the spread of COVID-19, and for the health and safety of all your guests, rules and regulations for pavilion reservations have been modified.

PRIOR TO MAKING A RESERVATION, YOU MUST AGREE TO FOLLOW THESE RESTRICTIONS.

The suggested maximum capacity for St. Peters pavilions have been lowered to allow for social distancing. The following maximum capacities are suggested:

In addition, everyone who attends the event must adhere to the following guidelines:

- Individuals who are sick or recently exposed to COVID-19 should not attend this event;
- Older adults and people who have severe underlying medical conditions should consider not attending this event;
- Individuals should practice good hygiene including; washing hands with soap and water, using hand sanitizer especially after touching surfaces, avoid touching their face, and sneeze or cough into a tissue;
- Items and surfaces should be disinfected frequently;
- Individuals should maximize physical distance from others according to CDC guidelines.
